

For: Boys and Girls intermediate and advanced levels. Intermediate players may not have a USTA district end of year ranking in the top 75% of the district.

What: Co-ed teams compete against other area teams based on age and level of playing ability. Divisions offered are: 10, 12, 14, 18 & under advanced & intermediate. You may play singles, doubles & mixed in each match. Matches run **2 hours**.

Where: Playing sites include: Goshen Middle School, Concord High School, Westview High School, Northwood High School and Northridge High School.

When: The season will run from June 20 - July 30. Days and times vary depending on the age division, level of play and playing site availability.

Approximate schedule:

10, 12 & under will play Fridays 1:00-3:00pm.

14 & under will play Thursdays 2:30-4:30pm.

18 & under will play Thursdays 4:30-6:30pm.

[Additional team play is offered at Goshen Middle School Mondays and Wednesdays 1:00-2:30pm for 10, 12, 14 & under for no additional charge]

Playoffs: Winning area teams may advance to the NIN District Playoff which will be July 29, at Concord High School. District winners may advance to Midwest Playoffs in Indianapolis August 11-13.

Attendance: There will be enough players in the league to sub or fill in if needed. Your team coach/manager will work out a playing schedule for the season for all players.

Cost: USTA membership: \$18 for the year. League fee of \$25 which covers all matches, balls, awards, t-shirt and site directors.

How Do I Sign Up?

1. Fill out a "team tennis entry form" or contact Patty Schrock @264-0611 or 533-2498.

2. If you do not enter an entire team, we will put you on a team with your friends or with others of similar ability. Your team coach will then contact you.

3. Team schedules will be given out by team coaches after the coaches meeting June 13.

4. All players must first obtain a USTA membership at usta.com Then, register for your own

team after your coach gives you the "team ID number" .

5.Matches will start the week of June 19. All players must be registered before playing!
